1904 - Golf Course Established

Original golf course established, beginning over 120 years of continuous recreational service to the Port Townsend community.

Natural Grass Putt-putt Course

The addition of a mini golf course at the public golf facility will create a fun, accessible space for youth and families, fostering early interest in the sport and increasing year-round community engagement.





Collaborative Playground Development

Partnership with City of Port Townsend to develop new playground facility that serves families visiting the course while enhancing community recreational opportunities and demonstrating ongoing municipal collaboration.

Our comprehensive revenue model projects breaking even by 2029 through diversified income streams including membership growth, program expansion, facility rentals, and strategic partnerships. The \$300,000 dedicated account for master use plan and mini golf demonstrates strong financial planning and community investment commitment.

Metrics Achievement & Performance Tracking

Our organization has consistently met and exceeded outlined performance metrics for the first two operational years, demonstrating strong management capability and community impact. These achievements validate our approach and support the case for long-term sustainability. (See Appendix E for full list)

Specific Examples:

- East West Trail will be fully established.
- Twelve "First Sunday" community events will be hosted each year.
- Clubhouse and restaurant will be refurbished and open six days a week.
- Course Superintendent will maintain certification in chemical application.
- \$20K investment will be made in new sprinkler heads.
- Course and greens will earn stellar reviews for quality and conditions. Natural areas will increase by 20%.
- An Environmental Stewardship Committee will be formed.
- Five new electric golf carts will be added to the fleet.
- Collaboration with the city will bring in a playground consultant.
- A youth-focused mini golf course will be added to increase activity and family engagement.

Our mission is to preserve (and steward) this 58-acre open space, offer affordable golf and multiuse recreation, increase public access, achieve environmental sustainability, and ensure long term financial sustainability.
